### **Before your On-site presentation**

All On-site presentations will be loaded in a single computer before the starting session. In case your presentation includes very large data files, please communicate with the chairperson.

### **Session 1            Oral Presentations (in Japanese)**

Participants who are not fluent in English, such as high school, undergraduate and graduate students, can present in this session. Each presenter will have at most 10 minutes (including presentation, question, and transition time to the next speaker).

### **Session 2 and 3    Oral Presentations (in English)**

Any young researchers (students, post-doc, assistant professor, etc.) can present in these sessions. Each presenter will have at most 20 minutes (including presentation, question, and transition time to the next speaker).

### **Best Presentation Award**

This will be voted for and awarded to two most accomplished Japanese and English presenters based on their research findings and the accompanied communication skills.
